The Military Tribunal Holden in the capital city of Yaoundé - Cameroun has sentenced Abdul Karim Ali - AKA in absentia to life imprisonment. This sentence was handed down by a three Panel Military Magistrates in the Military Tribunal on April 16, 2025 - three years after AKA was abducted in his hometown of Bamenda and transferred to Yaounde in La République du Cameroun to stand trial, as a civilian, in a Military Tribunal.

In May 2024, AKA through Counsel, formally put the Tribunal on notice renouncing it's jurisdiction over his person, as a Southern Caneroons citizen - AKA was categorical, in that letter, as he fervently is now, that he is an Ambazonian and hence not ready to surrender to the annexationist jurisdiction of La République du Cameroun.

While Counsel is concerting with him and advising themselves on the way forward the Human Rights community and the international community is hereby informed and put on notice on the continuous systemic and systematic violations of fundamental rights of Ambazonian Prisoners Of Conscience - APOC, especially, and the violations of all international instruments dealing with procedural and substantive inherent rights of fair trials for the APOC, by the state of Cameroun.

AKA is languishing in the Kondengui Central Prison since his transfer from the Secretariat of State Security - known more by its notorious French acronym - SED. It is very likely that he will be staying there.
